Peer-reviewed journal articles	■	■	a structured way of communicating the outcomes of your practical work
Grant proposals	■	■	made to share your own original research with other scientists or for reviewing the research conducted by others
Literature review articles	■	■	document that summarizes information or research concisely and attractively to help publicize and generate discussion - consists of brief text mixed with tables, graphs, pictures, and other presentation formats
Lab reports	■	■	short summary describing the contents of a scientific paper
Abstracts	■	■	outlines a project idea, explains why the organization needs money, and provides evidence that demonstrates the need and worthiness of the project
Infographics	■	■	articles which have gone through an evaluation process in which journal editors and other expert scholars critically assess the quality and scientific merit of the article and its research
Scientific poster	■	■	graphic visual representation of information, data or knowledge made to present complex information quickly and clearly
Journal article	■	■	critical recap of what has already been researched on a topic
