

# PRESENT CONTINUOUS

<b>Form</b>	Affirmative	S + am/is/are + V-ing She is cooking.
	Negative	S + am/is/are + not + V-ing She is not cooking.
	Interrogative	Am/is/are + S + V-ing Is she cooking?

Usage	Example	Time Expressions
Action happening now	Jim is watching television at the moment.	Now, at the moment, currently ...

### y + ing = ying



play = playing  
fly = flying  
study = studying



### e = e + ing



dance = dancing  
fake = faking  
rhyme = rhyming

### ee + ing = eeing



see = seeing  
flee = fleeing  
agree = agreeing

### ie = i + ying



die = dying  
lie = lying  
tie = tying



### c/v/c\* = double final c + ing



run = running  
put = putting  
stop = stopping
