10.2 Have / get something done

Use	Example
have / get + object + past participle this pattern is a mixture of active and passive; use <i>get</i> if the subject causes the action to be done. Both <i>have</i> and <i>get something done</i> can be used to express the following ideas: • when the subject of <i>have / get</i> does not do the action; someone else (usually someone who is paid to do it) does the action for the subject • to say that something unpleasant happened to the subject; more usual to use <i>have</i> in this pattern • to say that the subject completes an action rather than leaving it in the middle or leaving it until later; more usual to use <i>get</i> in this pattern	<i>I'm going to have / get my hair cut tomorrow.</i> <i>I'm having / getting my car repaired at the moment.</i> <i>You should have / get your eyes tested.</i> <i>She had her bag stolen last week.</i> <i>He had his leg broken in the accident.</i> <i>I must get this job done today.</i> <i>Let's get the house tidied and then we can go out.</i>
