In 1928, Robert Woodruff, who was the company's president at that time, led the expansion of CocaCola overseas when introducing the CocaCola to the Olympic Games for the first time.

The company's presence worldwide was growing rapidly and year after year CocaCola found a home in more and more places in the world. As for today, CocaCola has grown to be the world's most famous brand, with more than 1.4 billion beverage servings sold each day.
