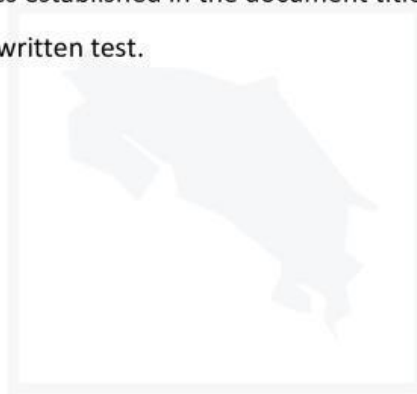

1. General considerations

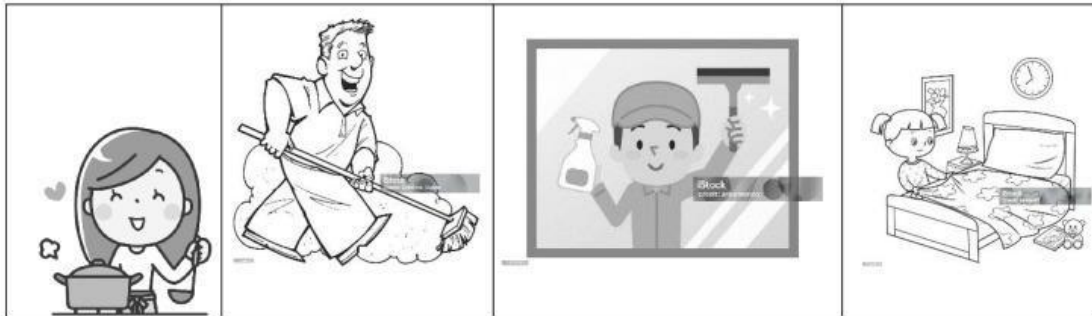
- Let students know what items or materials they need for the test.

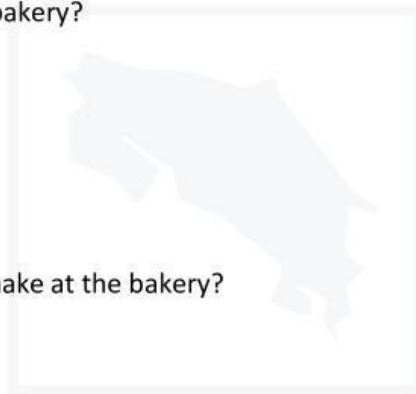
