

The British way of life?

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A new survey on the free time and shopping habits of British people is published this week – and it shows that we still love football, going to pubs, watching TV and eating fish and chips! Here are some of the results from the survey.



- The British are **always** happy when they're socialising. 55% of ^a go to a bar or pub with their friends **every week**.
- About ^c of adults go to a festival or a concert at least once a year and ^d go to the theatre. About 25% go to a museum or an art gallery.
- British people **generally** watch TV for about ^e hours every day – and about ^f of men have dinner and watch TV at the same time!

- The average British person spends more than ^g hours online **every month**, and a ^h that time is on social networking sites like Facebook and Twitter.
- ⁱ than half of all adults in the UK do some sport every month. About ^j British people go swimming and ^k play football – but 32% watch football on TV **once or twice a week**.
- British people **normally** go on holiday **once a year**, but ^l people have two or more holidays a year. The most popular holiday destination is ^m.
- ⁿ adults go to a McDonald's restaurant **every three months**, but ^o go to a traditional fish and chip shop.
- The British spend about £48 million on ^p and £56 million on ^q every month.
- And every British person eats ^r of chocolate every year – more than any other country in the world!
