Around the world, millions of students enjoy a long summer vacation each year. But some experts say that the traditional summer vacation has a negative effect on students' education.

Research¹ shows that during the summer, students forget approximately 30 percent of what they learned. Therefore, during the first month of school, teachers often have to repeat lessons from the year before rather than go on to new topics.

The long breaks from school affect children differently. Some families send their children to summer camps. Other parents buy summer books or pay for private lessons to help their children. But many families simply can't afford these things.

10 In the past, schools had to close during the summer because it was extremely hot and classrooms weren't air conditioned². But this is not a problem anymore because most classrooms have air conditioning.

Rather than one long summer vacation, schools should consider a shorter summer vacation with more short breaks during the year. It would help all students to get a better education. And who doesn't like frequent³ vacations?
