



✓ **Subject pronouns** are the subject of a verb. They go before the verb.

- *I like your dress.*
- *You are late.*
- *He is my friend.*
- *It often rains.*
- *She is on holiday.*
- *We live in England.*
- *They come from London.*

SUBJECT PRONOUNS	OBJECT PRONOUNS

HE (Mark)	HIM
SHE (Caitlin)	HER

✓ **Object pronouns** are the object of a verb. They go after the verb.

- *Can you help **me**, please?*
- *I can see **you**.*
- *She doesn't like **him**.*
- *I see **her** every Monday.*
- *We can see **him**, but he can't see **us**.*

✓ We use **object pronouns** after prepositions.

- *She is there **for me**.*
- *I'll get it **for you**.*
- *Give it **to him**.*
- *Can you listen **to her**?*
- *Don't take it **from us**.*
- *I want to speak **to them**.*
