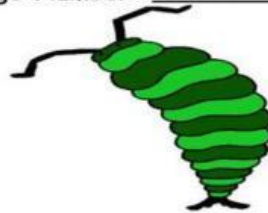

13. Match the picture with the correct stage of the flowering plant's life cycle.

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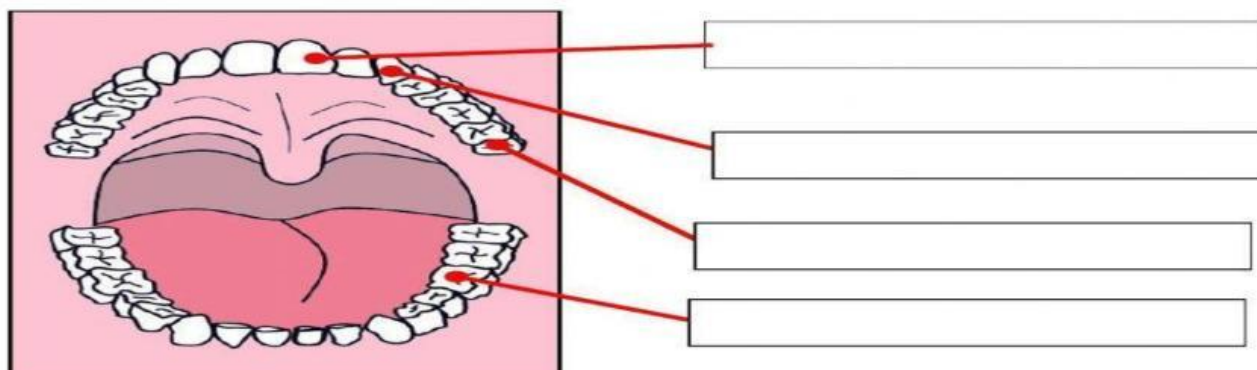

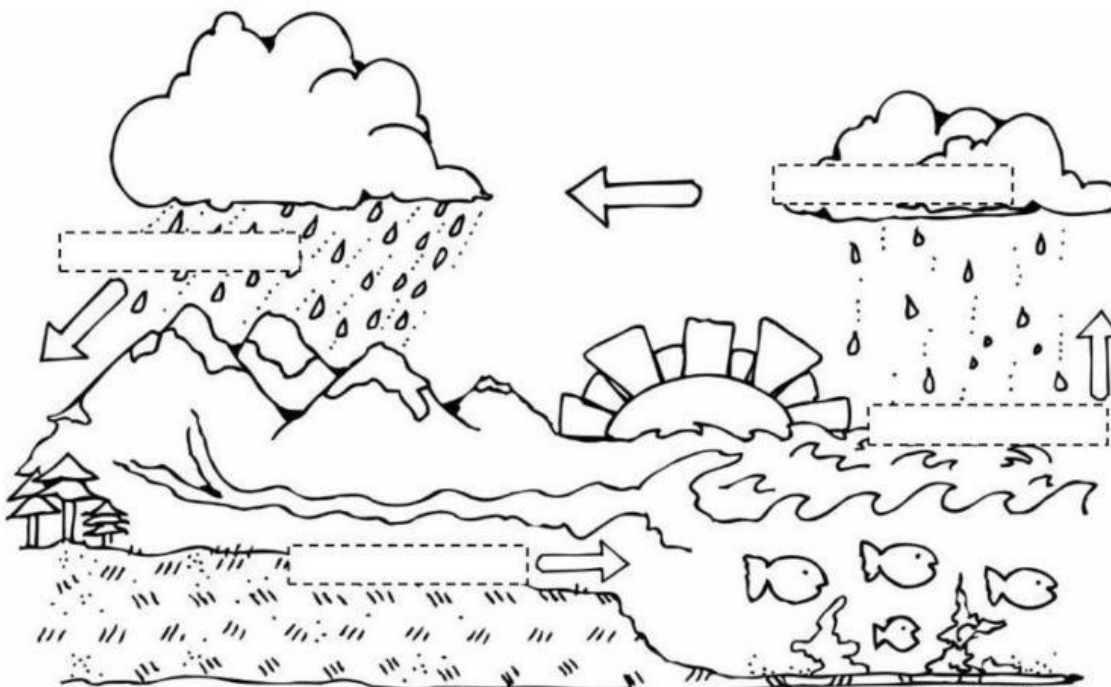
