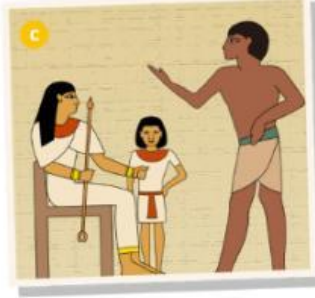

**Ancient Egyptian life and art**

We already know that cats were important to the Ancient Egyptians, but what else can we learn about their daily life from their art?

- ☒ Men and women had different jobs. Men usually worked outside, while women worked indoors at home. In paintings, women often have paler skin than men, to show this difference.
- ☐ Although most people wore very plain, simple clothes, Egyptian art often shows kings and queens wearing long, bright white clothes. This shows how important they were.
- ☐ Bread was one of the most important foods in Ancient Egypt, and everyone ate a lot of it. They also ate lots of vegetables and fish. Many sculptures and paintings show people making bread.
- ☐ In Ancient Egypt, doctors were thought to be the best in the whole world. There are paintings on papyrus of doctors treating patients.
