When a one-syllable verb ends in a consonant- vowel-consonant, double the final consonant and add -ed.	stop hug	stop ped hug ged
Do not double a final w or x.	show fix	showed fixed
When a two-syllable verb ends in a consonant- vowel-consonant, double the final consonant and add -ed only if the last syllable is stressed.	occur permit	occur red permit ted
