FUTURE SIMPLE <b>will / won't</b>	PRESENT CONTINUOUS <b>am/is/are + ING</b>	<b>to be going to</b> <b>am/is/are + going to</b>
I think we will go to Madrid.	We are going to Madrid.	We are going to go to Madrid.
