<b>1. Indefinite</b>			
I, We	Drink	drank	shall drink
You, They	Drink	drank	will drink
He, She, It	Drinks	drank	will drink
<b>2. Continuous (+ ing)</b>			
I	am drinking	was drinking	shall be drinking
We	are drinking	were drinking	shall be drinking
You, They	are drinking	were drinking	will be drinking
He, She, It	is drinking	was drinking	will be drinking
<b>3. Perfect (have/has/had + Past Participle)</b>			
I, We	have drunk	had drunk	shall have drunk
You, They	have drunk	had drunk	will have drunk
He, She, It	has drunk	had drunk	will have drunk
<b>4. Perfect Continuous (have/has/had+ been+ Present Participle)</b>			
I, We	have been drinking	had been drinking	shall have been drinking
You, They	have been drinking	had been drinking	will have been drinking
He, She, It	has been drinking	had been drinking	will have been drinking
