

PRESENT SIMPLE - SPELLING RULES ACTIVITY

I. Look at the 3rd person singular spelling rules of the present simple tense.

Present Tense

Spelling Rules	Examples
With most verbs, add s	live - lives sit – sits stay - stays
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add es	try – tries carry – carries
Ending in s, z, ch, or x add es	miss – misses buzz – buzzes catch – catches fix - fixes
Exceptions	go – goes do - does

Examples:

- She **plays** (**play**) the guitar every night.
- He **copies** (**copy**) his homework.
- My dog is crazy. It **jumps** (**jump**) everywhere.
- She **wishes** (**wish**) for ice cream.
