Affirmative	I/You/We/They (1)..... tennis. He/She/It (2)..... tennis.
Negative	I/You/We/They (3)..... play tennis. He/She/It doesn't play tennis.
Interrogative	(4) you play tennis? Yes, I/we do. / No, I/we don't. Does he play tennis? Yes, he does. / No, he (5) Do they play tennis? Yes, they (6) / No, they don't.

Present Continuous for Future Arrangements

Use a present form of **be** and a verb ending in **-ing** to talk about future arrangements.

Use **am** with **I**, **are** with **you/we/they** and **is** with **he/she/it**.

Affirmative	I (1)..... (I'm) practicing tomorrow.
	You (2)..... (You're) practicing tomorrow.
	He (3)..... (He's) practicing tomorrow.
Negative	I'm not practicing tomorrow.
	He's not (He (4).....) practicing tomorrow.
	They're not (They (5).....) practicing tomorrow.
Interrogative	(6)..... you running in the race at three o'clock?
	Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.
	(7)..... she running in the race at three o'clock?
	Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

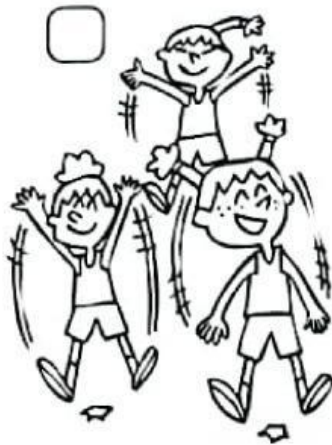

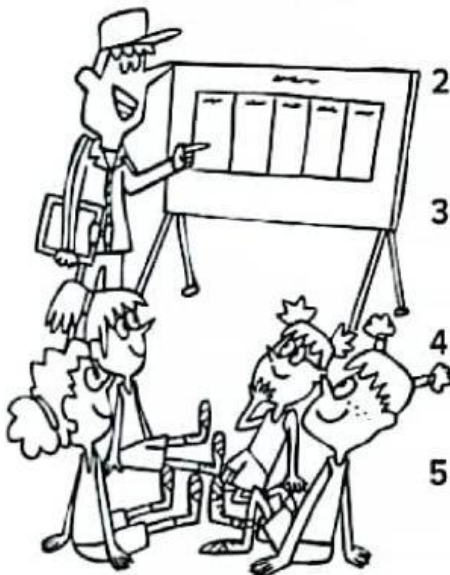

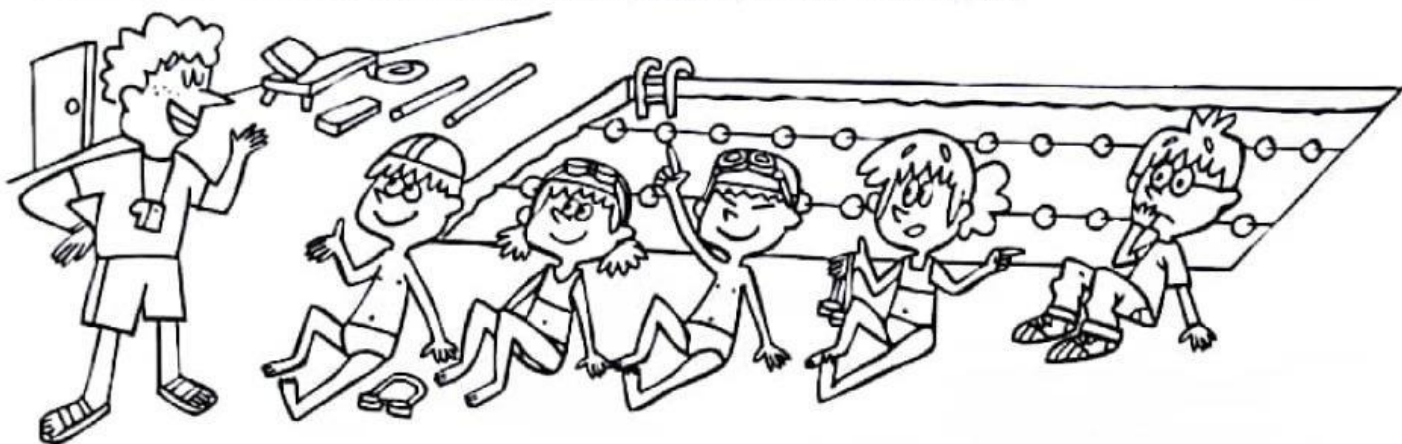
