

## MATCH THESE EXPRESSIONS WITH THEIR MEANING

<b>HIT THE GROUND RUNNING</b> <i>Let's hit the ground running by diving straight into our backlog items.</i>	To discuss and resolve a problem or disagreement through thorough and sometimes heated debate.
<b>FLESH OUT</b> <i>We need to flesh out the details of each backlog item to understand the scope.</i>	To examine something in detail or to analyze it thoroughly.
<b>NAIL DOWN</b> <i>Let's nail down the specific tasks required to achieve each backlog item.</i>	To add more substance or detail to something, making it more complete or comprehensive.
<b>HASH OUT</b> <i>During this meeting, we'll hash out any uncertainties regarding task assignments.</i>	To finish or conclude something, typically a meeting or discussion.
<b>ZERO IN ON</b> <i>We need to zero in on the critical backlog items for this spring.</i>	To start something quickly and energetically, without any delays.
<b>DRILL DOWN</b> <i>Let's drill down into the details of each task to ensure clarity and understanding.</i>	To finalize or firmly establish something, such as a plan or decision.
<b>WRAP UP</b> <i>As we wrap up the meeting, let's summarize our key takeaways and next steps.</i>	To focus closely and precisely on something, typically to identify or address an issue.
