In 1066, Normans who spoke French, conquered England and introduced more than 10,000 words.

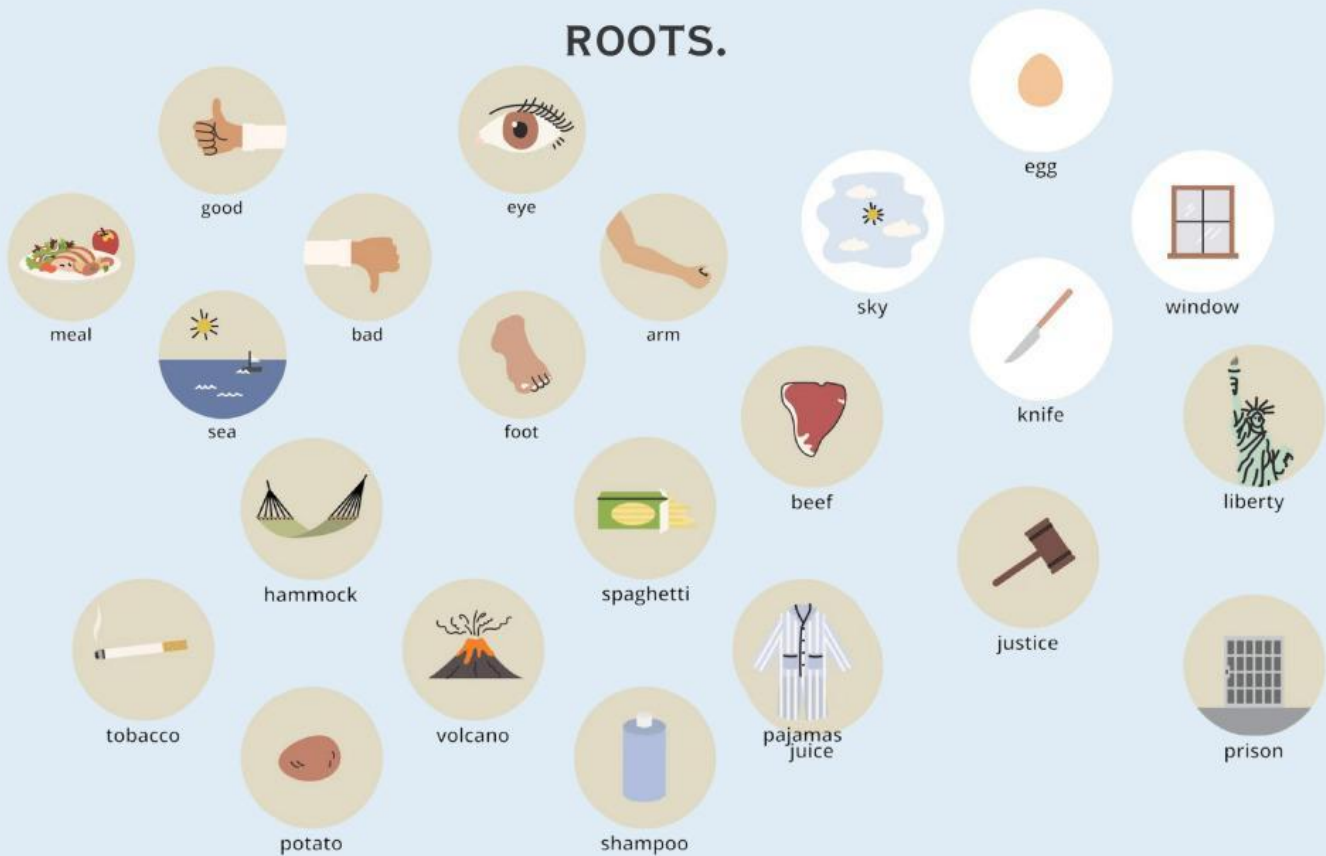
