Multiplying 2: Skip-counting

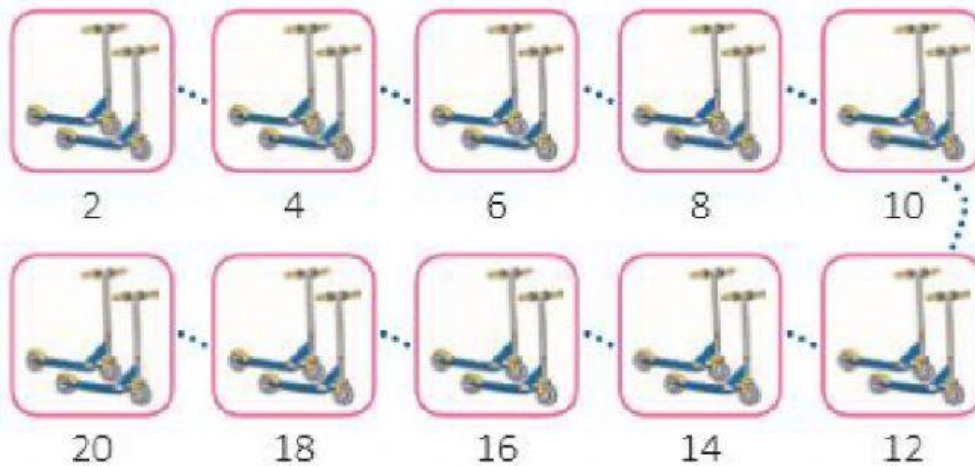
- 1 There are 2 skate scooters in 1 group.

$$1 \times 2 = 2$$

1 group of
2 skate scooters



How many skate scooters are there in 10 groups?



2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20

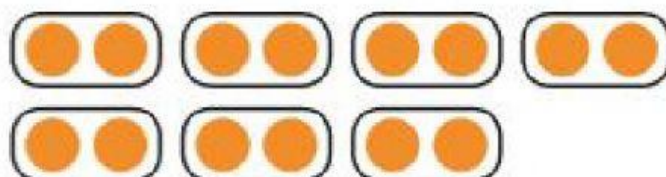
$$10 \times 2 = 20$$

There are 20 skate scooters.

I count in 2s.



- 2 Ali has 7 bags.
There are 2 pineapples in each bag.
How many pineapples does he have altogether?



$$7 \times 2 = ?$$

7 groups of 2 pineapples



2 4 6 8 10 12 ?

I count in 2s.
2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14

Ali has 14 pineapples altogether.



- 3 Sarah has 8 jars.
There are 2 guppies in each jar.
How many guppies does Sarah have altogether?

$$\square \times 2 = \square$$

8 groups of 2 guppies

I count in 2s.
2, , , ,
, , ,

Sarah has guppies altogether.
