

Significat d'alguns phrasal verbs amb **cut**

Cut back: reduir, fer retallades.

Cut down: reduir, reduir el consum.

Cut in: interrompre una reunió, una conversa.

Cut off: aïllar, tallar-se el telèfon.

Cut out: deixar de fer alguna cosa, de prendre alguna cosa

Cut across: agafar la ruta més ràpida.

Cut up: tallar a talls petita.

Estructura dels phrasals verbs

Verb + Preposició (+complement)

*My doctor advised me to **cut out** the cigarettes*

Verb + Complement + Preposició

*I have to **cut** the letter **down** because it's too long.*
