

Step 1: Presenting a position

Additionally, focusing on a specific profession early on can help me stay motivated and focused on my long-term career goals. And let's not forget about the possibility of earning money faster by entering the workforce sooner. These are some of the reasons why I'm considering vocational school. Step 2: Discussion

Me: Thanks for sharing. Why do you want to go to vocational school instead?
