### Vocabulary Builder

#### Phrasal verbs with *up* and *down*

Phrasal verbs with *up* often mean 'more'.  
*speed up* = go faster    *turn up* = make louder  
*warm up* = be/make warmer

Phrasal verbs with *down* often mean 'less'.  
*slow down* = go more slowly    *turn down* = make quieter  
*cool down* = make cooler
