series, soaps, and sitcoms

A **series** /'siəri:z/ is a set of TV programmes about the same subject or with the same characters. It is divided into **episodes**, which usually last between 30 minutes and an hour. When a series first comes out, episodes are usually broadcast once a week. A popular series may return for a second (third, etc.) **season**. **Streaming services** like Netflix now release complete seasons at a time. Sometimes a season is referred to as a **box set**.

A **soap** /səʊp/ (short for **soap opera**) is a story about the lives and problems of a group of people. It is broadcast several times a week, or even every day.

A **sitcom** /'sitkɒm/ (short for **situation comedy**) is a regular TV programme that shows the same characters in different amusing situations.
