Amelia Earhart

Aviator Amelia Earhart was born in Atchison, Kansas, USA, on July 24, 1897. She grew up in the upper-middle-class household of her maternal grandparents. She went to several different schools because she found it hard to do well academically and socially. However, she was very interested in science and sports. In 1923, she was known as "Lady Lindy" because she became the 16th woman to be issued a pilot's license. In 1928, she was also the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean as well as the first person to fly over both the Atlantic and Pacific. She mysteriously disappeared while trying to fly around the globe from the equator in 1937. There have been many speculative theories regarding Earhart's last days. They have been connected to various artifacts that have been found on Pacific islands such as tools, clothing, and more recently, Freckle cream. Finally, Earhart was declared dead in 1939.
