

The Present Simple Tense

USES

We use the Present Simple to talk about:

- Everyday activities e.g. *I go to school every day.*
- Habits and routines e.g. *I usually go out with my friends at weekends.*
- Permanent situations e.g. *I live in Cañada del Hoyo.*
- Likes and dislikes e.g. *I love pizza. e.g. I hate studying.*
- Stative verbs e.g. *I feel very happy today.*

Present Simple FORM Affirmative – Question – Negative

➢ I work	Do I work?	I don't work.
➢ You work	Do you work?	You don't work.
➢ He works	Does he work?	He doesn't work.
➢ She works	Does she work?	She doesn't work.
➢ It works	Does it work?	It doesn't work.
➢ We work	Do we work?	We don't work.
➢ You work	Do you work?	You don't work.
➢ They work	Do they work?	They don't work.

do+not= don't does+not=doesn't
