




FUTURE SIMPLE




AFFIRMATIVE FORM

 + **WILL** + VERB (-to)

→ I **will** stay home tonight.

→ She **will** wash the dishes tomorrow.

NEGATIVE FORM

 + **WILL** + not + VERB

→ She **will not** come next month.

→ We **won't** buy anything this afternoon.

→ **Will not = won't**

INTERROGATIVE FORM

WILL +  + VERB (-to)

→ **Will** you do it for me?

→ Where **will** they spend their weekend?

1) Write in the SIMPLE FUTURE:

E.g.: He - be - in Argentina tomorrow.
He **will be** in Argentina tomorrow.

a) I - be - in the second grade next year.

b) She - be - angry with me.

c) Mr. Green - be - my teacher next year.

2) Change to the future:

E.g.: I - change - my clothes.
I **will change** my clothes.
