SECOND CONDITIONAL

Structure

IF+ Past Simple, Present Conditional

(To be: use WERE) (would/wouldn't + Verb (bare form)).

Usage

Imaginary situations in the present or future

Examples



- If you **won** a million dollars, you **would buy** a new car.
Si tú ganaras un millón de dólares, tú comprarías un carro nuevo.
- If I **were** you, I **would quit** smoking.
Si yo fuera tú, yo dejaría de fumar.
- They **could stay** longer if they **had** more time.
Ellos podrían quedarse mas si ellos tuvieran más tiempo.
- If she **were** a millionaire, she **wouldn't** work.
Si ella fuera una millonaria, ella no trabajaría.
- If we **had** more free time, we **could travel** around the world.
Si nosotros tuviéramos mas tiempo libre, podríamos viajar alrededor del mundo.
