SPELLING

Adding 's' or 'es' to form the Plural

A **noun** names a person, place, thing, animal or idea.

A noun can be **singular** (one person, place or thing) or a noun can be **plural** (more than one person, place or thing).

Plural rules:

- To make regular nouns plural, add -s to the end.



cat



cats

- If the singular noun ends in -s, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, or -z, add -es at the end to make it plural.
