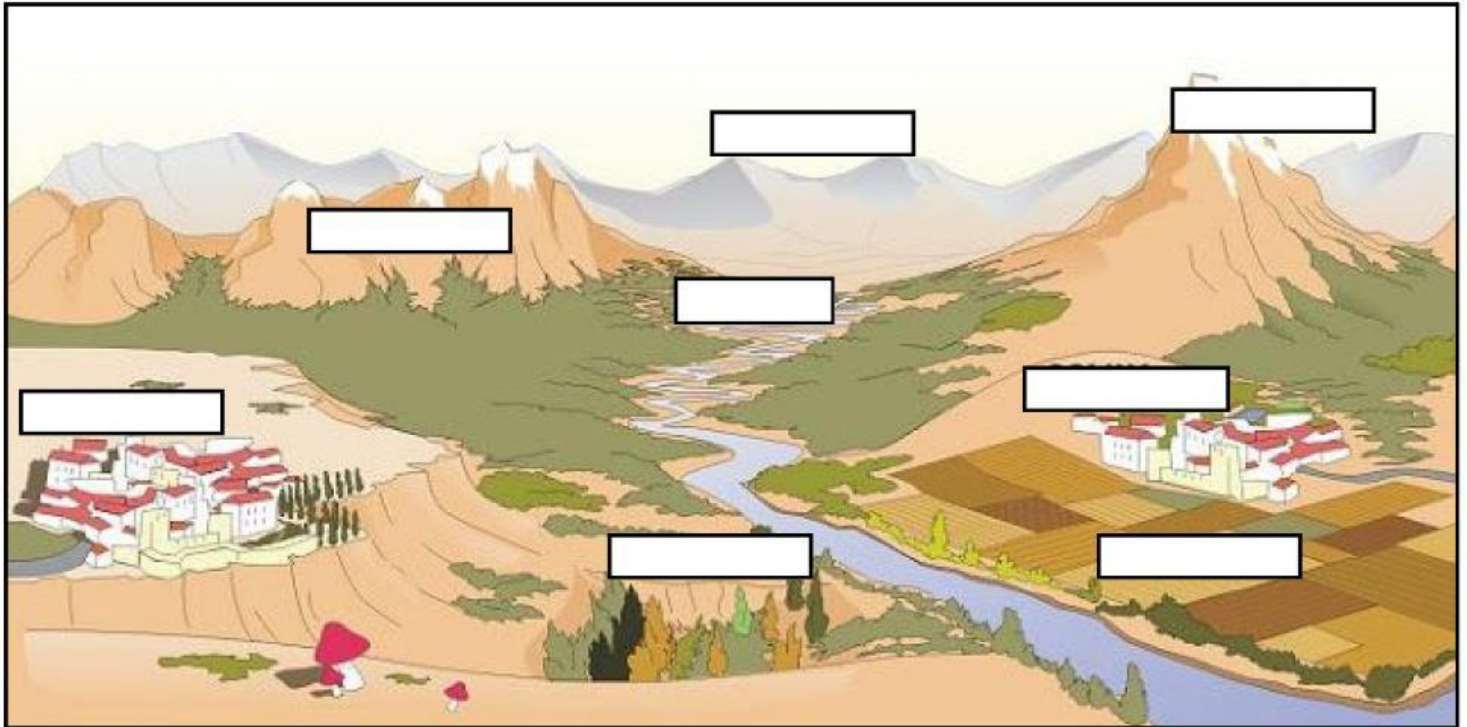


a. Write the elements of a flat and mountain landscape.

flat land.

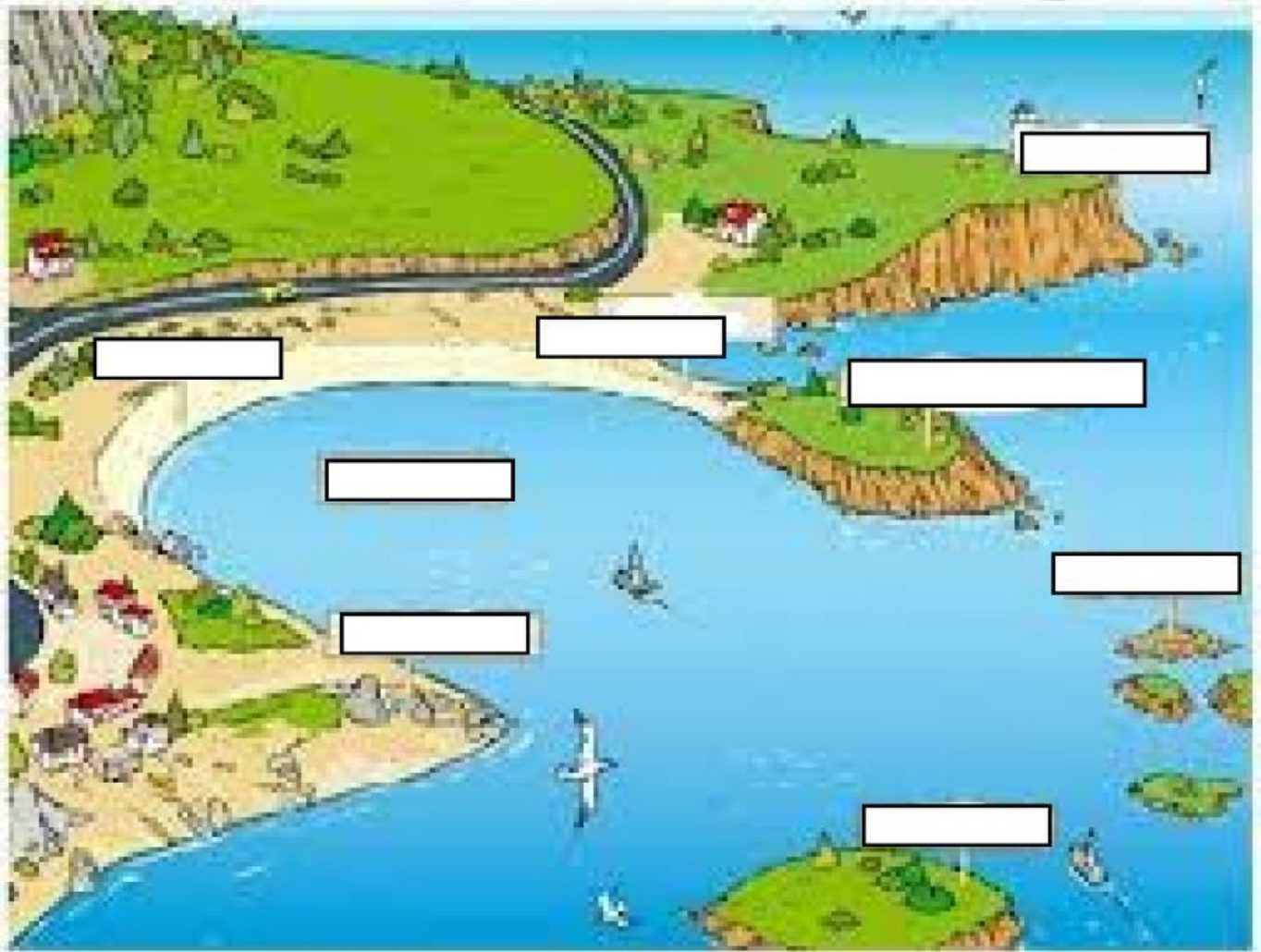
**HILL:**

c. Write the elements of a coastal landscape.

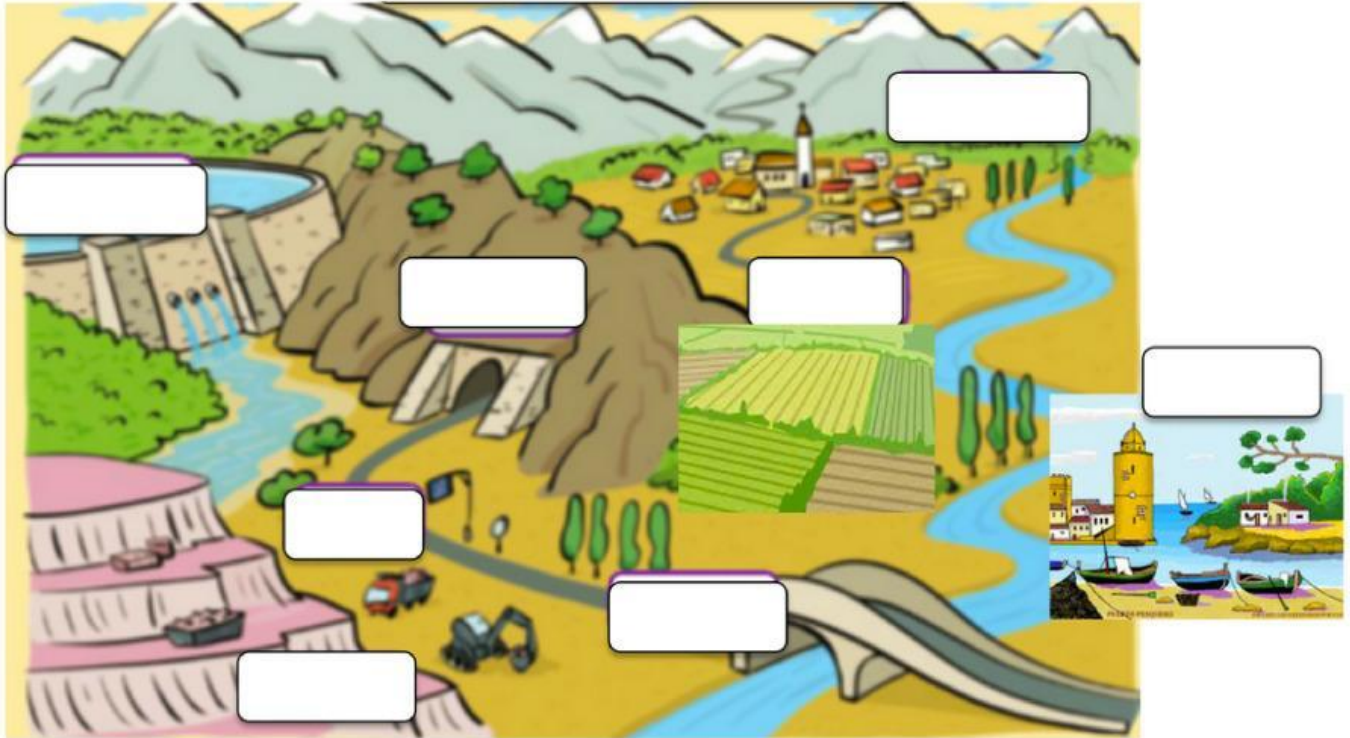


d. Drag and drop the definitions in the correct place.

PENINSULA:	small gulf.
INLAND:	a high rocky face.
