

- 4 It's a small percussion instrument. It is made of wood and metal. You shake it or hit it to make a sound.
- 5 It looks like a brass instrument, but it's in the woodwind family.
- 6 This small woodwind instrument is one of the earliest musical instruments. The musician holds it to the side and blows into it.




