

**Simple Past Review**

- We use Past Simple to talk about something that started and **finished** in the past.
- We use Past Simple with actions that happened **at a specific time in the past**. This is often marked with **time expressions** (yesterday, last week, 1 hour ago).
- We use Past Simple to talk about a **past state of being**, e.g. how we felt, what

	EXAMPLES	FORMULA
AFFIRMATIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I worked last weekend. • She went to the seaside last Sunday and spent a few days there. • Jorge was here 30 minutes ago. 	<p>person + verb + -ed (or +irregular form, e.g. go => went)</p> <p>to BE: person + was/were</p>
NEGATIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We didn't stop at the traffic lights and hit another car. • He didn't eat lunch yesterday. • Sammy wasn't very busy so he helped me with my tasks. 	<p>person + did not (didn't) + verb (infinitive)</p> <p>to BE: person + was/were not (wasn't/weren't)</p>
QUESTION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Did you come home late on Sunday? • What did we talk about a little while ago? • Where were you at 10 p.m. last Tuesday? 	<p>[Wh- question word] + did + person + verb (infinitive)</p> <p>to BE: [Wh- question word] + was/were + person</p>
