### My life as an actor *by Tanya Robinson*

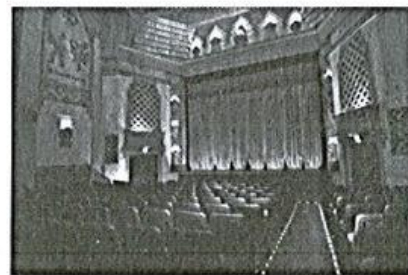
