instant decisions (taken while speaking) ➤ A: "We don't have sugar" B: "I'll buy some then."	decisions (taken before now - intentions/plans) ➤ Are you going to watch the game tonight?	future time clauses (when/ as soon as/until, etc.) ➤ I'll retire when I am 70. (NOT when I'll be 70). ➤ Call me as soon as you arrive .
promises and refusals ➤ I will help you but I won't lend you any money.		
offers ➤ I'll carry your bag. / Will I carry your bag?		
requests ➤ Will you open the door please?		
	present continuous plans (arrangements have been made) ➤ I'm flying to New York tomorrow morning. ➤ I'm seeing the dentist at 6. ➤ We are getting married next week.
