### 3. Time/place expressions

<b>now</b>	
'I'm working <b>now</b> ,' she said.	She said she was working <b>then</b> .
<b>today</b>	
'We're going to the factory <b>today</b> ,' he said.	He said they were going to the factory <b>that day</b> .
<b>tonight</b>	
'We're playing football <b>tonight</b> ,' he said.	He said they were playing football <b>that night</b> .
<b>yesterday</b>	
'I didn't go to school <b>yesterday</b> ,' she said.	She said she didn't go to school <b>the previous day / the day before</b> .



<b>tomorrow</b>	
'I'll bring your book <b>tomorrow</b> ,' she said.	She said she would bring my book <b>the next / following day</b> .
<b>last week / month</b>	
'Jorge retired <b>last month</b> ,' said Ana.	Ana said that Jorge had retired <b>the previous month</b> .
<b>next week / month</b>	
'I'll be away <b>next week</b> ,' said Tomas.	Tomas said he would be away <b>the following week</b> .
<b>this / these</b>	
' <b>This</b> password doesn't work,' said Gus.	Gus said <b>that</b> password didn't work.
<b>ago</b>	
'We went camping two weeks <b>ago</b> ,' said Saira.	Saira said they had gone camping two weeks <b>before</b> .
<b>at the moment</b>	
'Don is on the phone <b>at the moment</b> ,' he said.	He said that Don was on the phone <b>at that moment</b> .
<b>here</b>	
'Your laptop is <b>here</b> on the table,' Tess said.	Tess said that my laptop was <b>there</b> on the table.
