

Will/Won't (I'll, you'll, etc.)

We use **“will”** when we predict the future:

*“You **will** marry Prince Charming!”*

This use of **“will”** is common with expressions such as:
I think, I don't think, I expect, I'm sure, I wonder, probably, etc.

We use **“will”** when we offer to do something:

*Your friend tells you: “I haven't got any money!”
What do you answer? “Don't worry, I'll **lend** you some!”*



We use **“will”** when we promise to do something:



*“Don't worry mum, I'll **help** you with the washing-up!”*

We use **“will”** when we decide to do something at the moment of speaking:

*“It's a bit cold in this room!”
“Is it? I'll **turn** the heating on!”*
