We use the Past Continuous for actions **in progress in the past**.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I / He / She / It was playing.	I / He / She / It wasn't playing.	Was I / he / she / it playing?
We / You / They were playing.	We / You / They weren't playing.	Were we / you / they playing?
