

# PAST CONTINUOUS

We use the Past Continuous for actions **in progress in the past**.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I / He / She / It <b>was</b> playing.	I / He / She / It <b>wasn't</b> playing.	<b>Was</b> I / he / she / it playing?
We / You / They <b>were</b> playing.	We / You / They <b>weren't</b> playing.	<b>Were</b> we / you / they playing?
