



4A Present perfect with ever and never

We use the present perfect to talk about experiences in our lives.

I've visited China.

He hasn't been to Australia.

Have you worked in a restaurant?

We often use *ever* in a question with the present perfect. It emphasizes that we are talking about "our whole lives up to now".

Have you ever listened to classical music?

Have your parents ever been to a festival?

We often use *never* to make a negative sentence with the present perfect. It emphasizes that we are talking about "our whole lives up to now".

I've never tried Russian food.

He's never been to Scotland.

We form the present perfect with the verb *have* and the past participle of the main verb.

4.2	I / you / we / they	he / she / it
+	I've visited a lot of castles.	He's been to Vietnam.
-	They haven't studied Italian.	She hasn't played badminton.
?	Have you stayed in this hotel?	Has he worked in London?
Y/N	Yes, I have. / No, I haven't.	Yes, he has. / No, he hasn't.

Look! When we talk about experiences, we sometimes use *been to* instead of *gone to* to say that someone went somewhere and returned.

She's been to London three times. = (She went and returned.)
