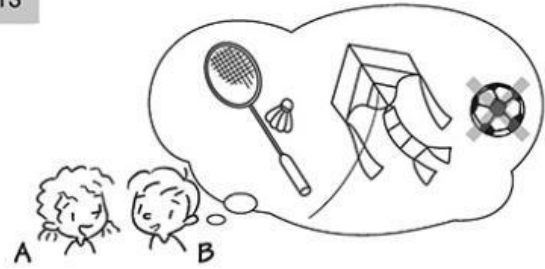


Future tense (2) questions • answers

 B: I'll **go** to a country park.
 A: What **will** you **do** there?
 B: I'll **play** badminton with my sister.
 A: **Will** you **fly** a kite there?
 B: Yes, we **will**.
 A: **Will** you **play** football there?
 B: No, we **won't**.



won't = will not

We use **will** to form questions and give answers about the future.

Will he ~~have~~ have a picnic tomorrow? No, he **won't**. He **will** ~~have~~ have a picnic next Friday.

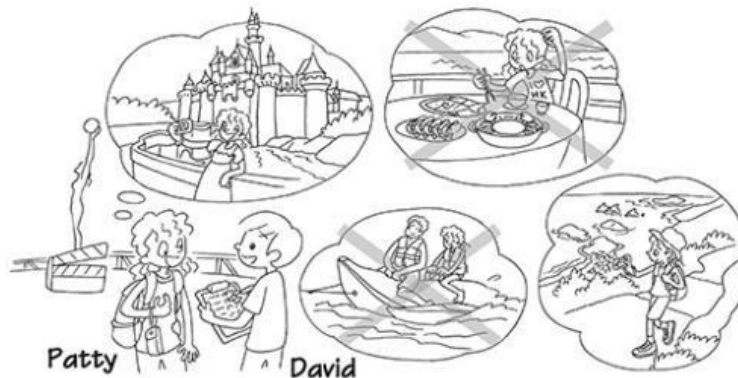
