a. to buy – bought – bought
4. We change a long sound to a short sound.
a. meet – met – met
5. We will change consonants and the vowels remain the same.
a. to make – made – made
6. The infinitive adds “en, n” to form the past participle.
a. to draw – drew – drawn
7. The simple past adds “en, n” to form the past participle
a. to break – broke – broken
