- **SHIFTING STONE**

In the past there was a natural granite stone weighing 300 tons, but in 1902 on February 29th it fell from the mountain. In 2007 they installed a recreation of the real one.



- **CERRO EL CENTINELA**

It is a big granite of 70 tons and 7 meters on a small base.

People go to the top in a chairlift, so you can see the beautiful sierras of Tandil.



- **MORISCO CASTLE**

This castle is located in the Independence Park at the top of the hill. It was a donation of the Spanish residents in Tandil.


Mar del Plata City
