1) Who are the intended readers? How do you know?

2) To what extent does the article achieve its purpose and meet the needs of intended readers? Explain your answer by analyzing and evaluating the strengths of the article and/or suggesting any ways that it could be improved.

Refer to detail in the text as you comment on:

- the information included (are there enough facts and different points of view given to support the writer's purpose? Is it accurate? Is it up to date? Would links to other sources be useful to a reader?)
- does the presentation, format and layout contribute to the meaning? Are they effective? Is the structure easy for a reader to follow? Could diagrams, charts or pictures help to communicate information and support the writer's purpose?)
- Are the words used formal or informal? Think about whether the words are easy for a general reader to understand or would only be understood by specialists?
