



# AT THE RESTAURANT!



We are going to read the following dialogue. The costumer's answers contain mistakes. Can you identify them and give an answer that you consider correct?

WAITER/WAITRESS	CUSTOMER
Welcome to All Stars Restaurant. How <b>many</b> tables do you need?	<i>One table for eight persons.</i>
Great! Follow me... Let me look for <b>a few</b> menus and <b>a little of</b> bread.	<i>OK. How many time do we have to wait?</i>
Here you have...it may t ake <b>some</b> time to get your food because we are full. May I take your order?	<i>Well, tell me how much the red wine. Pasta for main course.</i>
The red wine is 9 dollars. I will ask if we have <b>any</b> bottles left. Anything else you need?	<i>Yes, add a lots of grated cheese to the pasta.</i>
Fantastic! Wait here <b>a few</b> minutes and I will bring your drinks!	<i>OK.</i>
Here you have your drinks... The chef says your order won't take <b>much</b> time. I will be right back.	<i>I hope so.</i>
