

RECOUNT TEXT

RECOUNT TEXT IS A TEXT THAT TELLING THE READERS ABOUT ONE STORY, ACTION OR ACTIVITY. ITS PURPOSE IS TO ENTERTAIN OR INFORM THE READERS.

Generic Structure of Recount Text

1. Orientation:

It gives the readers the background information needed to understand the text, such as who was involved, where it happened, and when it happened.

2. Events:

A series of events, ordered in a chronological sequence.

3. Re-orientation:

A personal comment about the event or what happened in the end.

LANGUAGE FEATURES OF RECOUNT TEXT

1. USING THE SIMPLE PAST TENSE, PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE, PAST PERFECT TENSE, AND PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE.

2. USING TEMPORAL SEQUENCE, E.G. ON SATURDAY. ON MONDAY, ON SUNDAY

3. FOCUS ON SPECIFIC PARTICIPANT, E.G. I (THE WRITER)

4. USING THE CONJUNCTIONS, SUCH AS: THEN, BEFORE, AFTER, ETC.

5. USING ACTION VERD, E.G. WENT, STAYED
