1. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a small rubber craft carried on an aircraft or large boat which can be filled with air and used in an emergency.
2. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a small boat carried by ships in order to save people if the ship sinks.
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ is usually a ring filled with air or light material that floats, designed to help keep someone afloat in the water.
4. A \_\_\_\_\_ (2 words) is a small, fast rescue boat which large vessels, especially passenger ferries and cruise ships, use for man overboard situations.
