Jonathan Ross: What things do you remember then?...What things did he help you with?... Which things did he _____ you about? To become a better _____ or a better person...

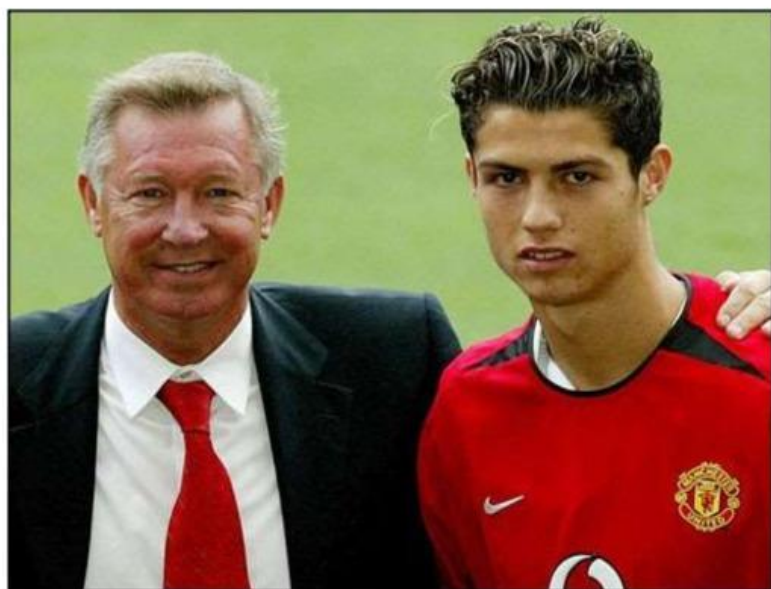
