Present simple

Present continuous

() Unfinished actions now

Use with: now, at the moment

() Temporary situations

Use with: at the moment, for a few weeks, for a couple of months.

() Temporary habits

Use with: always, forever, constantly

() Annoying habits

() Definite future

Use with: tomorrow, later, at 7pm tonight, on Tuesday

1. Two and two makes four.
2. I live in London.
3. Our train leaves at 11am.
4. I won't go out until it stops raining.
5. He takes the ball and scores a goal!
6. She plays beach tennis in Faria Lima every Tuesday



Present simple

Present continuous

() Short actions now

() Habits

Use with: twice a month, on Fridays, often, sometimes

() Facts

() Permanent situations

() Future timetables

Use with: this evening, at 10 o'clock, tomorrow

() Future in time clauses

Use with: until, when, as soon as, after, before
