The ao dai is Vietnam's national costume for women. The costume features wide trousers and a long, tight tunic top. The tunic is split on the sides so that the wearer can move easily. Its color varies depending on the age of the person wearing it. Young girls wear white, and unmarried women wear pastel shades. Married women wear rich-colored tops with simple black or white pants.

The kilt is a traditional Scottish cloth worn by men since the 16th century. Usually knee-length, this piece of cloth is wrapped around the man's hips and legs.
