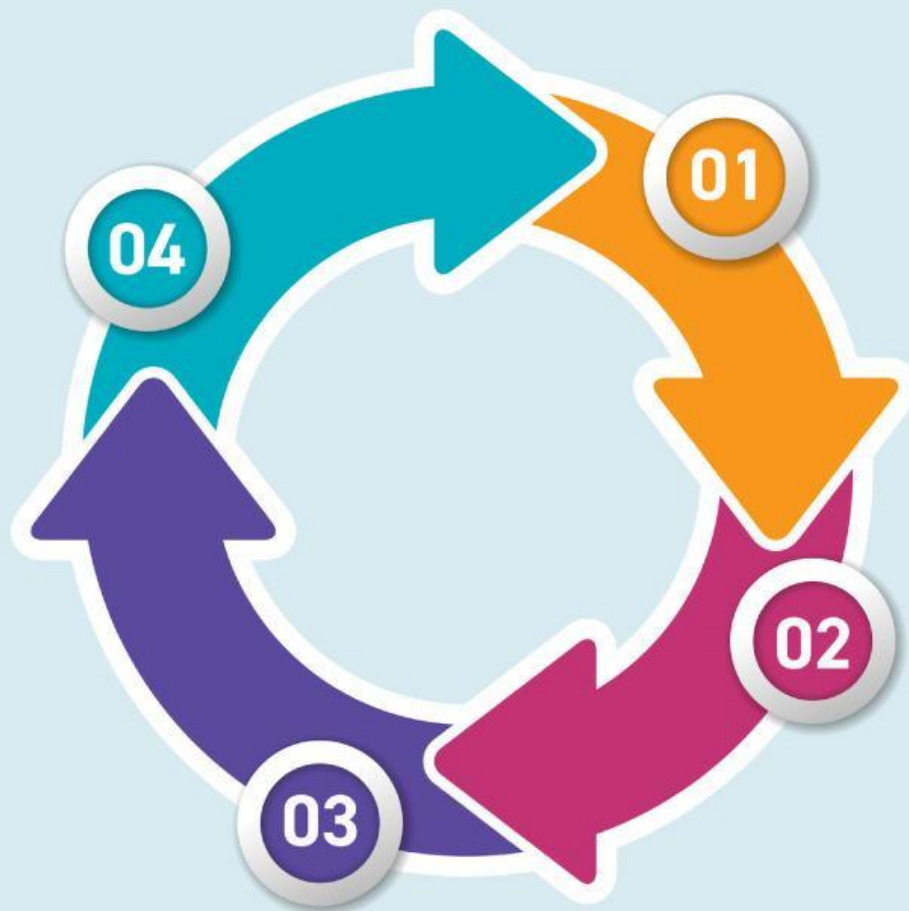

E. Meaningful Understanding

In daily activities, it cannot be separated from what is called an activity; almost every day we carry out activities, and when we do something, we have to explain it with structured and clear information. This is what will be studied in writing procedure texts.

F. Topic

Definition:

Procedure text is a type of text that explains how to do something in a step-by-step manner. It's like a recipe or instruction manual, guiding you through a process from beginning to end.

Purpose:

To provide clear instructions on how to complete a task, make something, or operate something.

Generic Structure:

Aim/Goal: This section introduces the purpose of the procedure. It can be found in the title itself or through a brief description explaining what will be accomplished by following the steps.

Materials/Tool: This section lists all the ingredients or equipment needed to complete the process. For food recipes, this might be called "Ingredients" while for assembling furniture, it might be called "Tools and Materials".

Step : This is the heart of the procedure text. Here, a numbered list or a series of sentences using transition words details each step chronologically. This section ensures the instructions are clear and easy to follow, guiding the reader from the beginning to the successful completion of the task.



Characteristic:

Typically, these texts follow a sequential format using the simple present tense and transition words like "first," "next," "then," and "finally." They also rely on action verbs and adverbs to provide details about time, place, and manner.



Language Features:

- **Simple Present Tense**: Since procedure texts focus on general instructions rather than specific instances, they primarily use the simple present tense. This emphasizes the fact-based nature of the steps involved.
- **Imperative Sentences**: These are commands that directly tell the reader what to do. Words like "mix," "add," "turn on," and "cut" are commonly used to guide the reader through each step.
- **Connectives (Kata Penghubung)**: Transition words like "first," "then," "next," "after that," and "finally" are essential for establishing a logical sequence between the steps. They ensure the reader progresses through the instructions smoothly.
- **Action Verbs (Kata Kerja Aktif)**: Verbs that describe actions are crucial in procedure texts. They provide specific details about what needs to be done at each stage. Examples include "pour," "stir," "heat," "assemble," and "insert."
- **Adverbs (Kata Keterangan)**: Adverbs can be used to provide additional details about the way an action should be performed. They can indicate frequency ("often"), time ("quickly"), manner ("carefully"), or degree ("completely"). For instance, "stir gently" or "bake for 30 minutes."

LANGUAGE FEATURES

HOW TO MAKE STINK BEAN FRIED RICE

Ingredients:

- Plate of white rice
- 1 egg
- 1 spring onion
- 4 red onions
- 2 cloves of garlic
- 6 red chilies
- 1 tbsp sweet soy sauce
- 1/2 tsp salt
- Right amount of oil
- Stink bean

Tools:

- Wok
- Spatula
- Plate
- Spoon
- Knife
- Blender

Steps:

1. First, heat cooking oil in a frying pan over medium heat.
2. Then blend the chilies by adding salt to them
3. Add the eggs and fry the eggs until cooked. Remove it and set it aside.
4. Saute the shallots, garlic and red chilies.
5. Add white rice and stir well with the spices.
6. Add sweet soy sauce, salt and green onions to the pan.
7. Add the *thinly* sliced stink bean to the pan.
8. Stir again until all ingredients are **evenly mixed**.
9. Cook the fried rice for 3-5 minutes over medium heat, **stirring occasionally**.
10. Remove the fried rice and serve on a plate.

HOW TO USE WASHING MACHINE

Tool:

- Washing machine
- Detergent
- Bucket
- Clothes freshener



Steps:

- First, separate the clothes by color and material
- Make sure that all clothes are empty without any coins, money and other light items
- Then prepare detergent (daia, rinso, and klin)
- Don't forget to provide fabric softener (downy, royale, molto)
- Put the clothes into the washing machine drum according to the washing machine capacity
- Add detergent and clothes fabric softener like downy and molto
- Turn on the washing machine: Press the start or power button to start the washing process
- The washing machine will stop spinning when the washing time is finished.
- Do not put your hands into a washing machine that is spinning
- Take out the clothes: Open the washing machine door and take out the clothes and dry them
- Put the clothes in the bucket
