Must – Mustn't

- We use **must** to say that something is necessary or very important to do.
- We use **must not** to say that something is not allowed.

Positive			Negative		
Subject	Modal	Base Verb	Subject	Modal	Base Verb
I/We/You/They	must	go.	I/We/You/They	must not (=mustn't)	go.
He/She/It			He/She/It		

You **must** be quiet.
You **must not** touch the vase.
