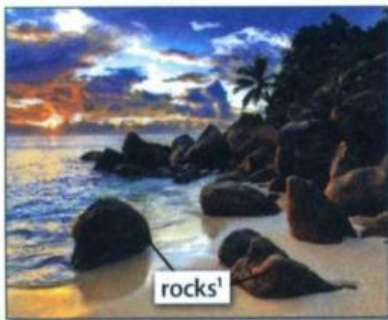

SPOTLIGHT *somewhere, anywhere, nowhere, everywhere*

- Somewhere** means 'in or to a place', but you do not say or know where.
 ■ They are **somewhere** in the Sahara Desert.
- Anywhere** is used in questions and negative sentences.
 ■ Is there a house **anywhere** on the island? I can't see a house **anywhere**.
- Nowhere** means 'in no place'.
 ■ There is **nowhere** to stay in this region.
- Everywhere** means 'in every place'.
 ■ There are rocks **everywhere** on the beach.
